Kidsafe programmes are age appropriate and are delivered throughout school on child protection; safeguarding; online safety, wellbeing; relationship and sex education; cyber bullying and stand alone; anger; domestic abuse; peer pressure; positive mental health and anti-bullying. The programmes are delivered by a trained tutor in school who knows the pupils/students well and personalises sessions to individual need and ability. Our aim is to protect and empower children with help from the puppet KS. The programmes teach children how to protect themselves from any type of abuse. Kidsafe teaches the children to talk to a trusted adult about any issues they may have.
