Dear parent/carers

The Government have provided the latest advice for schools on the 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2019. It indicates that:

**The EU Settlement Scheme**

Inform any staff, parents or carers of pupils who are EU, EEA or Swiss citizens that they need to apply to the EU Settlement Scheme to continue living in the UK after 2020.

If there's a no deal Brexit, the deadline for applying will be 31 December 2020.

Read the guidance on EU Settlement Scheme to find out who needs to apply.

Use the EU settlement scheme toolkit for employers to help your employees.

Irish citizens' right to live in the UK will not change when the UK leaves the EU. Irish citizens do not need to apply for the EU Settlement Scheme, but their family members, who are not Irish or British citizens, will need to.

The School has also considered further guidance in relation to Data Protection, food supplies and medical supplies. The School will also be following new EEA regulations regarding teacher sanctions or restrictions should we leave on 31<sup>st</sup> October.

As parents and carers do not inform us of their citizenship, we have sent this letter to all parents and carers for their information.
